## BETHLEHEM ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION & QUALIFICATIONS DEADLINE APRIL 1, 2020

- The applicant must have attended Bethlehem High School a minimum of four years including the entire senior year, and must graduate from BHS.
- 2. The scholarship recipient will be announced at your Senior Awards Day but will not be awarded until August 1, 2020 at the BHS Alumni Banquet in the BHS cafeteria.
- 3. Applicant must be of high moral character.
- 4. Applicant must submit <u>three letters</u> of recommendation as follows: one each from a teacher or administrator, a community leader, and a non=family member.
- 5. A copy of high school transcript through the first semester of applicant's senior year, showing SAT or ACT scores must be submitted with the application. (If SAT or ACT scores are not included on transcript, a separate copy of score sheet may be included.)
- 6. Proof of registration at a college, university, or vocational school must be submitted before scholarship is paid to applicant in August.
- 7. Proof of a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale must be presented.
- 8. In the case of a tie, finalists may be interviewed by an impartial committee whose members have no relation to the applicant. The decision of the Scholarship Committee will be final.
- 9. Three typed copies of an essay not to exceed three typed, double-spaced pages explaining your connection to BHS, your experiences at BHS, and/or your love of BHS. (Please do not give any names of family members in your essay; you may refer to them as, "my grandparents," "my aunts or uncles," "my parents, cousins, or siblings.")

<u>DEADLINE</u>; <u>APRIL 1, 2020 AT 9:00 A.M.</u> This is the deadline for submission of all requested paperwork for the BHS Alumni Scholarship. Turn all paperwork in to your guidance counselor at BHS by 9:00 A.M. on APRIL 1, 2020.
