Scholarship Application

The "Mr. Dady" Memorial Scholarship program recognizes college-bound or vocational/technical school-bound seniors who personify a strong work ethic, overall personal integrity and encompasses the true "Wildcat Spirit." One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to one senior based on the selection criteria listed below.

Donald "Mr. Dady" Dady retired from Bethlehem High School after 36 years where he held the positions of teacher, coach and assistant principal. Being a "Wildcat" was something that was very near and dear to his heart. He believed that each and every student deserved a listening ear and a helping hand. Through the scholarship program, his family hopes to continue his legacy by helping students achieve their dreams.

Guidelines:

- Applicants must attend Bethlehem High School.
- Applicants must be a senior with plans to attend college or a vocational/technical school.
- Decisions of the selection committee judges are final.
- Applicants should include the completed entry form and two letters of recommendation: e.g. church, school official, employer or community leader (300 words or less).
- Response to essay question should be typed, single spaced, on 8.5" x 11" paper.
- Copies of an original high-school transcript are acceptable for academic criteria.
- Applicants should retain a copy of their completed entry for their records.
- All submitted entries become the property of the Donald Dady "Mr. Dady" Memorial Scholarship committee and will be shredded upon completion of the current year's scholarship program.

Criteria:

Students should demonstrate their commitment to highly ethical behavior and provide documentation in the following areas:

- **Integrity** – Describe any extracurricular work or school-related activities. Include awards or honors or offices held.
- **Academic** – Describe your post-secondary education plans and enclose a copy of your most recent transcript.
- **Essay** – Write a concise essay (not to exceed 500 words) on your response to the following:
 - Why do you consider yourself to have a strong work ethic?
 - How have you shown integrity in your day to day life?
 - How has the BHS Wildcat community helped you become who you are today?
